Canadian Closed Championship April 28 & 29, 2023 GENERAL RULES



Closing Date for Entries: Sunday, April 16, 2023

GENERAL AMATEUR RULES

- All amateur competitors must have a current DSAB, CDS or WDSF affiliate membership.
- Juvenile couples are allowed to compete in the Junior I and Junior II events except at championship level.
- Youth couples are allowed to compete in Adult events. In all age groups one partner of a couple can belong to a younger age-group, except in the Senior I, Senior II, Senior III and Senior IV age groups.
- All competitors must be ready 1 hour before their event and present themselves for costume check. In case of tardiness, the competition will not be delayed.
- In the student/student competition only the lower-level student is being judged. The higher-level student has to have danced at least one level higher than the lower level student in past competitions. Only the student being adjudicated pays entry fees in this category.
- All competitors require to have paid their registration fees.
- Juvenile and Junior competitors require admission tickets for the session(s) of the event(s) entered. Youth, Adult and Senior competitors require full-day (evening) admission tickets.
- The use of spray tan on the premises is strictly forbidden.
- At check-in, bib numbers have a \$5.00 deposit, refundable upon return.

PAYMENT, LATE ENTRY and REFUND POLICY

- > Early bird price deadline: April 2, 2023.
- Registration deadline and fee payment is Sunday, April 16, 2019. Any registrations after this date are at the discretion of the organizers and are subject to late fees.
- Registrations without payment of entry fees are not considered valid and will not be entered.
- > Payment details are provided on the Summary Sheet.
- The organizer has the right to cancel any event. Cancelled events will be refunded.
- > There are no refunds on entry fees or tickets purchased
- > Entry forms must accompany the summary sheet.
- Entries and payment must be received by the <u>registrar</u> by dates quoted to receive early bird prices or to avoid late fees. Entries and payment given or sent to anyone other than the registrar are not considered received.

WAIVER & LIABILITY

All amateurs and professionals (and, if under age 18, their parents or legal guardians) must sign the release on the individual entry form to be eligible to compete.

AGE CLASSIFICATION

The following age classifications are based upon the individual's birthday which occurs within the calendar year:

- Juvenile I: 9th birthday or less
- > Juvenile II: 10th or 11th birthday
- Junior I: 12th or 13th birthday
- > Junior II: 14th or 15th birthday
- > Youth: 16th, 17th or 18th birthday
- > Under 21:16th, 17th, 18th, 19th or 20th birthday
- > Adult: 19th birthday or more
- Senior I: One partner must have reached his or her 35th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 30th birthday.
- Senior II: One partner must have reached his or her 45th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 40th birthday.
- Senior III: One partner must have reached his or her 55th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 50th birthday.
- Senior IV:One partner must have reached his or her 65th birthday or more. The other partner must have reached her or his 60th birthday or more
